At least 50% of the credit hours required for the major/minor must be earned at WWU. For a minor, a maximum of 12 credits may apply.

  - Study Arabic Language at all levels in addition to coursework in English through ISA's Morocco program in Meknes; the summer program allows for students to earn 10 quarter credits in 5 weeks, the semester program provides 18-27 quarter credits, and the service learning programs offers 12 or 8 week programs for credit, or as an add-on to summer or semester programs

## Costa Rica

  - Students can study at Veritas University in San Jose through AIFS or CEA and take Spanish language at all levels, in addition to coursework in English in a variety of areas
  - Spend 3 months studying Tropical Ecology and Conservation in Monteverde, Costa Rica earning 15 quarter credits for the CIEE summer program that include tuition, housing, meals, and cultural activities
  - API offers intensive language quarter and summer term options in San Jose and San Joaquin de Flores
  - Participate in the Heredia program, or consider an Intensive Month of Spanish Language + an 8-week service learning program for credit through ISA in San Jose, allowing students to earn 7 quarter credits for intensive language and 5-9 quarter credits for the service learning component, equaling at least 12 credits
