WWU Global Learning Faculty – Led Programs

Global Learning Programs are sponsored by a WWU department and generally consist of a faculty member taking a group of students to study discipline based courses abroad. Study with other WWU students and learn from WWU faculty all while paying WWU tuition and in-country program fees

- [Mexico- TESOL in Queretaro](#)- Earn Western credits during the summer towards your degree and certificate that will qualify you to teach English around the world by participating in an eight week cultural immersion and teaching experience in the beautiful Mexican city of Queretaro; no language requirement; must apply to TESOL program and complete TESL 401, 404, 405, and 420 prior to program
- [Mexico- Understanding and Supporting ELLs](#)- Learn the history, culture, and language of Mexico while also studying about ELLs, assessments, and methods during the summer for a 5 week program putting knowledge into practice by teaching students English; must have completed ELL 431 & 432 and the ELL Endorsement Program OR permission of the instructor
- [Guatemala – Building Cross Cultural Connections](#) - Students will earn 10 credits during the summer term exploring the history, politics, cultures, and social issues of Guatemala while expanding cultural competence by engaging in cross cultural service and immersion. Students will work with children and families in educational, health, and food distribution projects while developing an understanding of global citizenship
- [Kenya- Fields Studies and Collaborative International Service Learning](#)- Students will earn 15 credits during the winter quarter discovering the culture and politics of Kenya, exploring challenges that rural Kenyans face, examining grassroots approaches to community development, and applying these perspectives
- [Rwanda – Field Studies & Collaborative International Service Learning](#) - Students will earn 12 credits during the summer term exploring the history and cultures of Rwanda and actively collaborating with in-country experts to implement field experiences and service learning. Projects may include working with local community based and government organizations in areas of teaching English as a second language, and more
- [South Africa – Nongovernmental Organizations in Development](#) - Students will earn 12 credits during the summer term exploring the growing role of nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) in bringing social development to this dynamic and promising African country. Students will explore the richness and diversity of African communities, examine social justice issues, and gain experience through service-learning projects
